

Hastings Band Boosters

Meeting Minutes

November 2, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 7 pm by Connie Kolodziej.

Attendees: Duane Oldham, Rick Hardy, Heidi Bohlken, Joe Becker, Connie Kolodziej, Jim Jacobsen, Emily Chandler, Mike Ventry, and Terri Ventry.

A motion was made by Heidi, seconded by Rick, to approve the September minutes as submitted. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: There is a balance of \$16,425.80. There is a bill for \$307.75 for the color guard sabers pending. The balance will be about \$18,738.71.

Band Director Reports:

Emily: Marching band season is wrapped up. There were 88 kids in fall band. 37 were rookies and 26 of them were freshmen. The season went well. There were more families that are unable to pay. There is currently more than \$4,000 outstanding. 12 students needed scholarships. The fee was \$600-700 for camp and fees. We will explore using forfeited funds to make up this difference but this could be an ongoing issue.

Duane: There is a concert in 2 weeks.

Jim: There was a wind ensemble concert last Thursday that was outstanding.

Old Business:

Ford Fundraiser: We raised \$2,440. Park High School did the fundraiser at their school which may be a future idea. We could use the front lot at the middle school. There were 103 drivers and 23 workers. We will take \$1.36 per drive for Boosters for a total of \$172. We will put \$18 per drive or shift worked into each kid's account. There was \$97 donated through the food truck.

Poinsettia sale: Orders have been taken. About 60% of the sales were for show choir. Checks were run through school accounts instead of booster accounts. Profits will be distributed into program accounts and then student accounts. Flower delivery will be December 5.

Cub bagging: December 20-24 are our dates. A brass quintet will play. We have 2 new team leads, Dianne Talley and Chey Holm. They are all set up with deposit envelopes.

Spain trip: There are 23 kids signed up to go. It has ended up being a non-performance trip. The rotation will be a trip every 3 years.

Garage sale: The newspaper has decided to table this idea until next year.

New Business:

Connie will call to get Boosters added to the cardboard dumpster at Ace Hardware.

The next meeting will be held January 18, 2016.

A motion was made by Rick, seconded by Connie, to adjourn. Motion carried.
